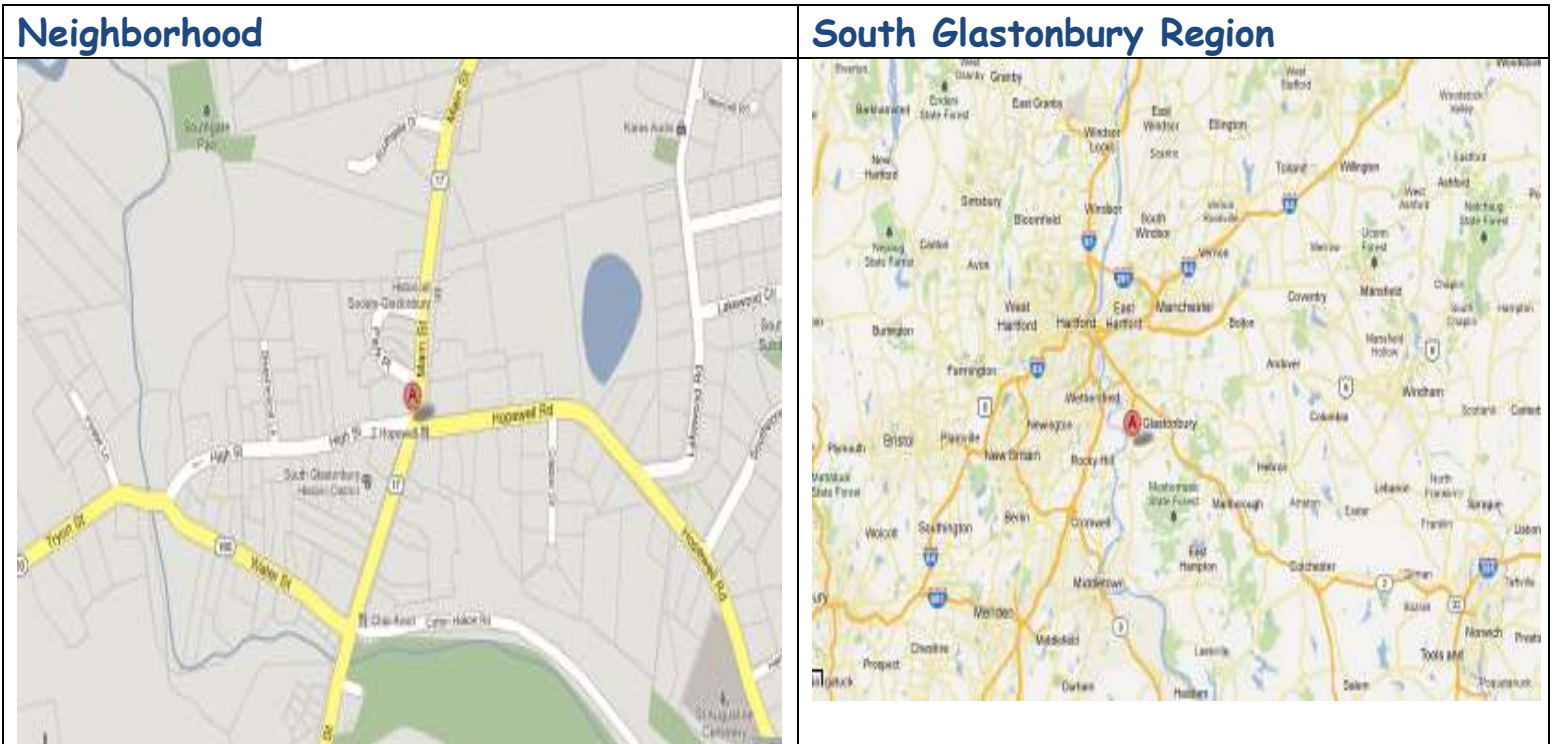

# Directions to The Congregational Church in South Glastonbury 949 Main Street (CT Rte. 17) South Glastonbury, CT



## From the North and West

Take I-84 E toward BOSTON.  
Merge onto CT-2 E via exit number 55 toward NORWICH/NEW LONDON. 4.4 miles  
Merge onto CT-17 S via exit number 7- on the left- toward PORTLAND. 3.8 miles  
South Church is on right at corner of Main and High Streets.

## From the East

Take CT-2 W toward HARTFORD.  
Take the EXIT 10 E. GLASTONBURY/MANCHESTER 0.1 miles  
LEFT at end of exit ramp onto CT-83/MANCHESTER 0.2 miles  
At the stop sign RIGHT onto NEW LONDON TURNPIKE 0.6 miles  
Take SECOND LEFT onto . CHESTNUT HILL RD 2.6 miles  
LEFT onto CT-17/MAIN ST. 0.5 miles  
South Church is on right at corner of Main and High Streets 0.1 miles.

## From the South

Take I-91 N toward HARTFORD  
Merge onto CT-3 N via exit number 25 toward GLASTONBURY.  
Merge onto CT-2 E toward NORWICH. 0.7 miles  
Merge onto CT-17 S via exit number 7- on the left- toward PORTLAND. 3.8 miles  
South Church is on right at corner of Main and High Streets.
